

Vestibular Rate Schedule

- 1.01 In order for the applicable Services to be eligible for the rates in this Schedule they must meet the following requirements collectively referred to as the “**Eligibility Criteria**”:
- (a) the Services must be for a Manitoba Public Insurance claimant;
 - (b) the Services must be for an initial vestibular physiotherapy assessment and/or vestibular physiotherapy treatment;
 - (c) the Manitoba Public Insurance claimant must be referred to a service provider that has signed a vestibular agreement with Manitoba Public Insurance confirming that a credential review has been completed and they have met the standard of competency based vestibular training, prior to Service Provider performing the Services. For greater clarity, any performance of the Services by the Service Provider prior to the credential review with Manitoba Public Insurance would be paid in accordance with the regular rates of the Agreement;
 - (d) the Services are performed only by the individual specified on the signing page; and,
 - (e) the Service Provider complies with all other reporting and invoicing requirements of this Agreement.
- 1.02 The Service Provider shall submit an initial report to Manitoba Public Insurance outlining the assessment findings.
- 1.03 Hourly rates for vestibular physiotherapy treatment do not apply. It is agreed that an initial vestibular assessment and up to three (3) vestibular physiotherapy treatments can be billed while undergoing review of the initial report. If vestibular physiotherapy treatment is approved, the number of approved treatment sessions will be communicated by Manitoba Public Insurance to the Service Provider. If the Service Provider believes that more vestibular physiotherapy treatments are needed for the claimant to treat the motor vehicle accident condition, then a subsequent form report shall be submitted by the Service Provider to Manitoba Public Insurance for review in accordance with the Agreement.
- 1.04 The Service Provider shall use form reports for all types of conditions, and not just for orthopedic conditions.
- 1.05 Subject to the Physiotherapy - Legal Terms, in consideration of the Services that meet the Eligibility Criteria and are performed to the reasonable satisfaction of Manitoba Public Insurance during the Term, Manitoba Public Insurance agrees to pay to the Service Provider at the following established rates:
- Initial Vestibular Assessment - \$195.00
 - Vestibular Physiotherapy Treatment - \$117.00
 - Form Reports - \$72
